## 2023-2024 EXIT Program by the Numbers



- · 169 women contacted RESET and were put on the waitlist
- $\cdot$  70 women and their children entered the EXIT Program
- 9500+ safe & secure nights provided to women and children
- · 86% were considered homeless at intake \*
- · 92% had issues with addiction
- · 24% of the women identify as Indigenous, First Nations or Métis
- · 38% of the women were pregnant or had children



#### **Health & Wellness**

- · 98% were supported with their physical health
- · 100% received mental health support
- · 100% indicated their mental health had improved due to the EXIT program
- $\cdot$ 100% indicated their physical health had improved due to the EXIT program



#### **Legal & Justice**

- · 16% came to RESET directly from a correctional facility
- $\cdot$  36% were supported in addressing legal issues they were facing



#### **Community Support - Phase 3**

- · 78 women were supported with 275+ different supports
- · 76% increased their employability
- · 50% received academic support
- 93% were housed and no longer struggled with stable housing







Over 200 people volunteered over 2,500 hours



# **Our Impact**

SROI analysis of RESET outcomes in 2023-2024 show that:

For every \$1 invested into EXIT, approximately \$13 in social and economic value is created.



# **Key EXIT Program Outcomes**

The EXIT Program creates valuable positive outcomes for multiple stakeholders, including Participants, children of Participants and government services and systems. These outcomes can be articulated in monetary terms using the SROI methodology to understand how much social value is created for every dollar invested. Key outcomes from the EXIT Program that have been valued in monetary terms using the SROI methodology include:

- Decreased homelessness
- Decreased harm from substance use
- Decreased experiences of violence
- Improved health during pregnancy
- Decreased exposure of children to harmful situations

- Decreased emergency system use (e.g. EMS, hospital, police)
- Increased ability to stay together as family & decreased child welfare system involvement
- Decreased criminal justice system. involvement
